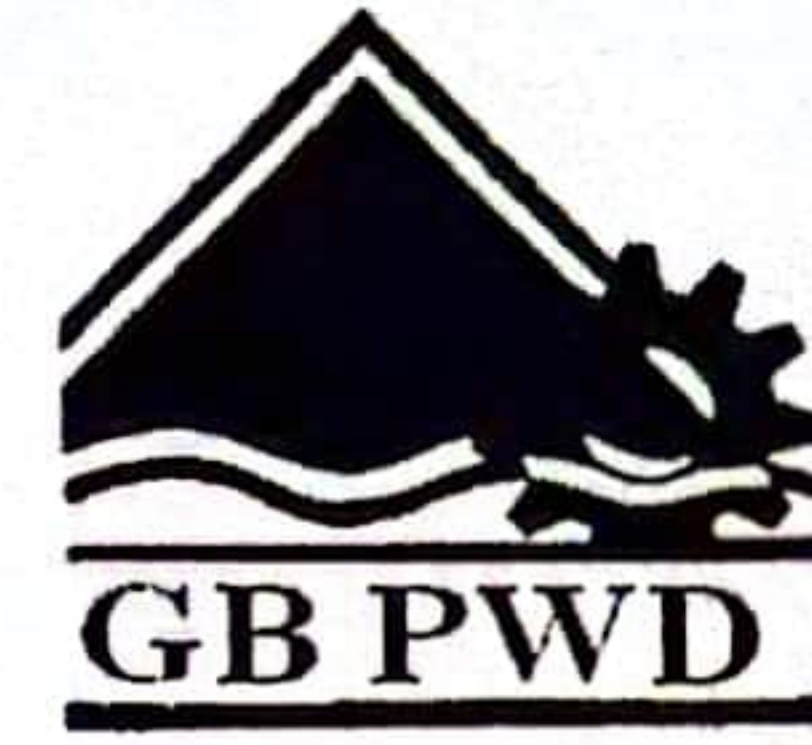

C&W department (GB) B&R Division Kharmang invites sealed bids under single stage two envelope (SSTE) bidding procedure, from well reputed and experienced contractors/firms/JV registered having valid PEC Registration renewed up to 30th June, 2024 with relevant category/code for the work mentioned below:



Prospective eligible bidders may get bidding documents as per shown along with written application having properly diary and dispatch numbered may obtain personally, a set of bidding documents immediately after the advertisement published in the newspapers etc. The said application shall be mandatorily accompanied with the following documents failing which, it shall be treated as non-responsive and summarily rejected.

(A) Eligibility Criteria:

01. PEC valid Registration for CFY (2023-2024) with relevant category and code.
02. Latest profile of the constructors/firm/JV from PEC website.
03. Renewal receipt for CFY (2023-24).
04. NOC for no Sick Project in hand from Works Secretariat/affidavit by the contractor.
05. CNIC of the Prospective bidder/firm/JV.
06. Certificate in the form of Affidavit of No delayed project/s Court Case/Litigation with C&W Department and Water & Power Department GB
07. Bid security as specified in shape of CDR from any scheduled bank.
08. In case of JV agreement, it should be executed on proper format duly signed by both partners of JV clearly mentioning share of each partner and lead partner duly attested by Magistrate Ist class. Both JV members should have the required category and codes. Number of JV members shall not be more than (03) three.
09. Only one bid will be entertained either as single bidder or JV partner.
10. Bank statement should be properly stamped and signed by the concerned Bank Manager.
11. The Qualification and Evaluation Criteria is enclosed with the bidding documents. All the bidders are directed to fill the form duly certified on an affidavit on a judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100.
12. The call deposit in shape of CDR provided by the bidder along with bid will be verified from the relevant bank prior to acceptance of the technical bid by the concerned authority, bid security shall be as specified in the NIT.
13. The qualification of bidder will be based on all the criteria given in the following table regarding the bidders financial soundness, experience, personal capabilities and equipment capabilities be dealt in accordance with PEC bidding documents and GB-PPRA Rule 2022.
14. The qualification status shall be decided on the basis of pass/fail. The bidder must obtain at least secure at least 60% score in overall categories.

15. The pre-bid meeting will be held in the office of the Superintending Engineer C&W Ghanche/Kharmang Circle Camp office Kharmang on 03-05-2024 at 10:00 AM
16. No bid shall be accepted beyond closing of time as mentioned against each work
17. In case of any deviation, conflict in bidding procedure the provision of PEC & GB PPRA 2022 shall prevail
18. All terms and condition of procurement process guidelines issued be Works Secretariat vide Notification No. Sec-SO-D-9(28)/2022-23/475 dated 26th January, 2023 and PEC bidding document shall be part of procurement.
19. In case of Gazetted holiday/ local holiday bid will be opened on next working day without further intimation.
20. Overwriting on bidding document is not allowed and in case of any overwriting/omission is found it shall be properly initialed by the contractor
21. The subletting of contract, if any shall be filled in the given format in the bidding document and same shall be made part of contract agreement, otherwise subletting shall not be allowed.
22. Technical and financial bids shall be opened by the procurement committee as notified C&W secretariat.
23. Signing of all pages of bidding documents, integrity pact and self-evaluation checklist shall be mandatory, failing which the bid shall be treated as non-responsive and summarily be rejected in the initial screening phase.
24. Rates quoted below 10% from TS cost shall be required to provide along with his bids and additional performance grantee of 50% of the deferential amount (Between TS and Bid) in Shape of CDR/Bank Guarantee from any schedule bank of Pakistan or grantee bound from any AA rating insurance company duly certified /vetted by the Head office of the insurance company.
25. Bid Validity period shall be 120 days after the date of opening of the financial bid.
26. Performance guarantee shall be @ 10% of the contract amount from any scheduled bank/ insurance company having AA radding.
27. Bids shall be opened in the Office of the Superintending Engineer (Chairman) Biding Evaluation Committee Near Baltaro Rest House at Circle office skardu.
