Public Procurement Reforms are being pursued vigorously by the government. The Authority since its establishment in the year 2002 has undertaken measures to regulate procurement of goods, services and works. The major objective is to optimize efficiency, promote competition, provide even treatment to the bidders and to promote fairness in the procurement process. Its objective also includes eradicating corruption and ensure across the board accountability in public procurement. PPRA's endeavor to introduce transparent Public Procurement will go a long way in promoting transparency and accountability, main pillars of development and democratic dispensation.

Introduction:

The Public Procurement Regulatory Authority is an autonomous body endowed with the responsibility of prescribing regulations and procedures for public procurements by Federal Government owned public sector organizations with a view to improve governance, management, transparency, accountability and quality of public procurement of goods, works and services.

It is also endowed with the responsibility of monitoring procurement by public sector agencies/organizations and has been delegated necessary powers under the Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Ordinance 2002.


PPRA's Capacity Building Program

PPRA has established a training center under *Public Sector Capacity Building Project (PSCBP)* and put in place an elaborate training mechanism including infrastructure/training staff. Three-day training courses are conducted on weekly basis to impart training to the public sector officials for individual / institutional capacity building.

The training modules include education, case studies and practical implementation issues relating to public procurement regulatory framework along with other important procurement related modules like Project Management, International Procurement Perspective, Accountability/Consequences of mis-procurement. More than 87 training courses have been conducted, in which over 2800 participants from over 200 organizations have participated. In addition to that, resource persons of PPRA have been visiting different organizations to impart onspot training at the request of procurement agencies. Moreover, special presentations/lectures were also delivered on the training centers of different organizations like AGPR, CAA, NBP, HEC, National Education Academy and Secretariat Training Institute.




PPRA Website:
