<u>Instructions to Bidders</u>

1. Title of the Contract

Provision of comprehensive insurance coverage/service for the building of the Consul General of Pakistan, Montreal for a period of one year starting from **28**th **April 2024**.

2. Scope of the Contract

- i. The objective of the tendering procedure is to conclude a contract with the successful tenderer for comprehensive insurance arrangements for the Consulate General's building, located at 3421 Rue Peel, H3A 1W7, Montreal, QC, Canada, for a period of 12 months starting 28th April 2024, with the possibility for renewal/s.
- ii. Specifications of the building are given in Annex-A.

3. Service requirement

The bidders must be in the position to fulfil the following requirements:

- i. Advise the Consulate General on the best and most cost-effective insurance solution for its needs.
- ii. Appoint an agent as the contact person for the Consulate General to provide constant service through the whole year.

4. Risks to be Covered

Fire, explosion, smoke, storm, breakages of glass, electricity risks, water damage, natural disasters (including earthquake, snow, flood etc.), theft, arson, vandalism, vehicular impact, airplane crashes, etc.

5. Settlements of Claims
