


NOTICE FOR TIMBER AUCTION (CUT WOOD) – 2025

It is notified for the general public at large and interested bidders that the auction of various types of cut wood pieces collected and lying in WCB Nursery, Walton Cantonment Board is being held at the office of Cantonment Board Walton on 27-05-2025 at 12 PM on the basis of "As available as it is". Aspirants are required to take advantage of this golden opportunity and to participate in open public auction / bidding accordingly. If auction could not be held due to any unavoidable circumstances, it shall be held on the next working day at 12 PM hours. The detail of cut-wood lots is given as under:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS AUCTION:

1. The interested persons shall have to deposit CDR. Worth Rs. 50,000 /- AS token money before the auction in this office along with copy of CNIC. After auction the CDR will be returned except to the highest bidder. Cash will not be accepted as token money.
2. The successful bidder is not allowed to sell the timber before he removes it from the site.
3. Without token money, no persons / contractor will be allowed to participate in the auction.
4. The highest bidder shall have to deposit 1/4 of bid at the fall of hammer and balance amount will have to be deposited within 07 days from the receipt of approval from the competent authority.
5. In case the balance amount of bid is not deposited by the successful bidder within the prescribed period the 1/4th bid money already deposited by him will be forfeited in favor of Government and wood will be put to re-auction at his risk and cost.
6. The successful bidder shall deposit advance Income Tax & GST any other taxes imposed by the Govt.
7. The highest bidder shall deposit 1/4th of bid as security with this office before issuance of permit which will be refunded to the highest bidder after the trees are removed and site is leveled without any loss to the Government property or private property.
8. The successful bidder shall be responsible for any damage caused by him to Govt / private property during the removal of trees and the successful bidder will have to pay full amount of damage.
9. If the trees are not removed within prescribed period, cost of cut wood already deposited shall be forfeited to Govt fund and cut wood shall be disposed off by the Govt as deemed fit without any compensation of original bidder.
10. The security deposited by the successful bidder shall be forfeited in case of breach of any conditions of auction notice.
11. The details of cut wood to be auctioned or other information required may be obtained from the office of the undersigned during working hours before the auction date.
