**Technical Evaluation:**


Tender opening meeting was held at F-block, NARC, Islamabad for provision of 1,593,000 olive nursery plants and supply and installation of drip system for 1,000 acres was held on 19<sup>th</sup> day of November 2024".

Technical evaluation was conducted on 19<sup>th</sup> day of November 2024 and Three firms namely, M/s Izhar Farms Pvt. Ltd. Lahore, M/s Agrixum Nursery Farms, Lahore and M/s National Nursery, Quetta submitted their bids for evaluation. It was concluded that two firms namely M/s Izhar Farms Pvt. Ltd. Lahore and M/s Agrixum Nursery Farms, Lahore met the criteria mentioned in the tender document and M/s National Nursery, Quetta could not qualify technically.

The inspection committee duly approved by competent authority\* visited the facilities of M/s Agrixum nursery farms in two locations in Nowshera, Soon valley and Jhang and recommended that the nursery has all the facilities and adequate number of plants for further procurement processing.

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




### Financial Evaluation:
