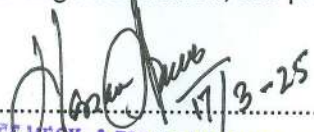

MISCELLANEOUS WORK OF ABOVE WATER DREDGER TSHD ABUL
TECHNICAL EVALUATION REPORT

1. It is submitted that with the approval of competent authority the subject tenders were invite through press advertisement under PPRA rule 36 (b) (i.e. single stage two envelop procedure) and the same were published in the newspapers on dated 25-12-2024 and accordingly uploaded on KPT and PPRA websites. Tender bid opened on dated 15-01-2025.
2. In response following 03 bidders participated and submitted technical offers.
 - I. M/s ESA Engineers.
 - II. M/s AJCL (Pvt) Ltd.
 - III. M/s Al Meena Marine Engineers.
3. In this regards, first meeting of technical evaluation committee was held in the office of CM&EE-I (Convener). The meeting was chaired by CM&EE-I and following members attended the meeting.
 - I. CM&EE-I (Convener).
 - II. DY.CME (W/S) (Member)
 - III. DY.CME (F/C-I & II) (Member)
 - IV. Asst. Manager Finance(Member)
 - V. AEE (C) (Member)

4. During the meeting the technical proposal reviewed by above technical committee and discusses the technical proposal.

5. The second meeting of the committee was held in the CM&EE-I office and all the committee members attended the meeting. During the meeting technical proposal was reviewed by above technical committee and after detailed deliberations some discrepancies were observed in the bid documents of two firms i.e. M/s ESA Engineers & M/s. AJCL (Pvt) Ltd regarding mandatory requirement of evaluation criteria and other terms & conditions and same were forwarded to Dy.CEE (S&C) vide letter No. /Misc Work of above water/25/10 dated 24-01-2025 wherein, the following shortcoming clarification were asked from the bidders to furnish:

CLARIFICATIONS:

- A) M/s. ESA Engineers**
- a) Documentary proof of professional capability.
 - i. Managerial staff C.Vs.
 - ii. Technical Staff C.Vs.
 - iii. Documentary proof work facility.

B). M/s. AJCL (Pvt) Ltd.

- a) Copy of PEC 03 years audited financial statement is to be provided showing minimum average turnover of 100 million
- b) Copy of PEC certificate in relevant category as mentioned in mandatory requirement of Technical Evaluation Criteria.
- c) Copy of experience Certificate for ship / crafts repair and maintenance contract as per TEC requirements.
- d) Documentary proof of work facility as per TEC requirements.

6. In response, the above mentioned bidders submitted their clarification /desired shortcomings documents to DY.CEE(S&C) and same were received to Convener of TEC, through Dy. Chief Elect Engg (S&C) letter No.(M)GT/Misc work of above water/2024/63 dated 03-02-2025.

7. Later on, the third meeting of the committee held in the office of CM&EE-I and all committee members attended the meeting. The committee again discussed the response /documents received from the above two bidders and reviewed the mandatory conditions of evaluation criteria. The Technical Evaluation Committee scrutinized the clarification / documents furnished by both the firms. Further, TEC was of the view that the authenticity of the copies of purchase orders provided by M/s. AJCL towards their experience awarded by M/s. DAMEN are required to be checked / verified. In this regard, the Convener of TEC i.e. CM&EE-I sent an e-mail to M/s. DAMEN on 12-02-2025 (at 12:08 Pm) to confirm the genuineness of the said purchase orders. In response, M/s. DAMEN vide e-mail dated 12-02-2025 (02:52 Pm) confirmed the authenticity of the said purchase orders.

8. Later on, the fourth meeting of the committee was held in the office of CM&EE -I and all committee members attended the meeting. The committee again discuss the response / confirmation received from M/s. DAMEN and is of the view that the copies of purchase orders submitted by M/s. AJCL towards their work experience are acceptable. In addition to above, Convener of TEC also asked vide letter dated 18-02-2025 that all 03 tendered participating firms may be asked to submit their User & work completion certificates of their work experience of purchase / work orders within 07 days. Accordingly, same were communicated to the respective firm vide letter dated 20-02-2025.

9. In response to above, two firms i.e. M/s. AJCL (Pvt) Ltd vide their letter dated 24-02-2025 & M/s. Al Meena Marine Engineers vide their letters dated 26-02-2025 furnished the desired documents. However, M/s. ESA Engineers vide their letter dated 25-02-2025 communicated that they have requested to M/s. KS&EW (i.e User) to furnished the User Certificate.

10. The Fifth meeting was held in the office of CM&EE -I, Committee Room, West Wharf on 27-02-2025 at 10:00 am. All committee members attended the meeting. The committee scrutinized the user certificates furnished by two firm i.e. M/s. AJCL & M/s. Al Meena Marine Engineers and found acceptable. Further, reply of M/s. ESA Engineers was also discussed and agreed with the justification furnished by the firm. During meeting, one of the member of TEC i.e. DY.CME(W/S) was of the view that the work facility of M/s. AJCL (Pvt) Ltd and M/s. ESA Engineers may be checked / verified on their given addresses through by KPT's Port Intelligence Department.

12. Accordingly, the Convener of TEC vide letter dated 27-02-2025 requested to Director Port Intelligence for verification of work facility of both the firms. It was confirmed by the KPT's Port Intelligence Deptt. to the TEC that the workshop inspection of both the firm's were conducted by KPT's Port Intelligence representatives on **28-02-2025**. Later on, Director Port Intelligence KPT vide his letter No. PID/299 dated 03-03-2025 reported as under:

13. In the meantime, M/s. AJCL (Pvt) Ltd vide letter No. AJCL/CM&EE-II-KPT/LTR-250224-001483 dated 28-02-2025 (received in CM&EE-II office on 03-03-2025 vide IR # 430 dated 03-03-2025) wherein firm have communicated as under:

1	The KPT technical team has visited our proposed workshop facility as included in our technical bid package. During the site visit, the details and images submitted were thoroughly verified, confirming the accuracy of the information provided.
2	AJCL is available to provide the collaboration certificate / latter between IRE and AJCL Pvt Ltd upon request.
3	We have selected IRE as our exclusive partner due to our successful history of collaboration and their extensive experience working with KPT and Karachi Shipyard and Engineering Works. This strategic partnership underscores our commitment to fulfilling the requirements of the subject tender and ensuring its successful execution. Additionally, KPT's technical team has witnessed maritime jobs being undertaken at our facility, including the servicing of propellers and shaft bearings for a Karachi – based client, further demonstrating our technical capability and reinforcing the relevance of our expertise to the subject tender

14. Regarding provisioning of User Certificates, M/s. ESA Engineers vide their letter dated 11-03-2025 furnished the desired documents and same appears as acceptable by TEC.
15. To conclude the TEC Report, the 6th and final meeting called by CM&EE -I (Convener) in the CM&EE Tender Committee Room No 32 KPT on 06-03-2025 at 12:00 pm and same attended by all the members of TEC. The TEC unanimously agreed that **after opening of the tender**, the matter communicated by M/s. AJCL (Pvt) Ltd in letter No. AJCL/CM&EE-II-KPT/LTR-250224-001483 dated 28-02-2025 (received in CM&EE-II office on 03-03-2025 vide IR # 430 dated 03-03-2025) **regarding collaboration between M/s. IRE and M/s. AJCL (Pvt) Ltd is not viable**. After threadbare discussion, TEC prepared /finalized the Technical Evaluation Criteria, Proforma 'A' & 'B', and also the concluded and recommends as under:

RECOMMENDATIONS.

- i. The Technical Evaluation Committee unanimously declares the Technical Proposal / Bid of two firms i.e. M/s. ESA Engineers and M/s. Al Meena Marine Engineers as **"Technically Responsive and acceptable"**. Therefore, recommends that the Financial Bids of both the firms may be opened after obtaining necessary approval of the Competent Authority.
- ii. The Technical Evaluation Committee unanimously declares the Technical Proposal / Bid of M/s. AJCL (Pvt) Ltd as **"Technically Non -Responsive and Not acceptable"** due to the reason that in the Technical Evaluation Criteria category "Professional Capability, the firm have obtained 18.5 Marks which is Less than minimum qualifying marks i.e. 21 Marks. Therefore, TEC recommends that the sealed Financial Bid of M/s. AJCL (Pvt) Ltd may be returned to firm after obtaining necessary approval of the Competent Authority.
