Above mentioned bidder does not have PEC registration certificate with technical code of EE-04 & EE-05 which is mandatory requirement of TEC for said tender.

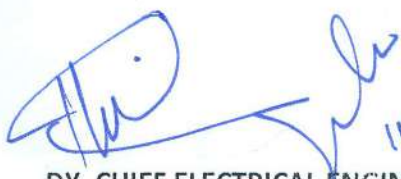
2. M/s. Al Meena Marine Engineers

TECHNICAL EVALUATION REPORT

1. It is submitted that with the approval of Competent Authority the subject tenders were invited through press advertisement under PPRA rule 36(b) (i.e. single stage two envelope procedure) and the same were published in the newspapers on 21-01-2025 and accordingly uploaded on KPT and PPRA websites. The last date of issue of tender was fixed on 18-02-2025. Tender Bid opened on 19-02-2025 at 11:30 hours.
2. In response following three bidders participated and submitted Technical offers.
 - i. M/s. SSR Enterprises
 - ii. M/s. Al Meena Marine Engineers
 - iii. M/s. Dreams Unlimited
3. In this regards, first meeting of technical evaluation committee was held on 25-02-2025 at 10:00 hrs in the office of DYCEE(O&M). The meeting was chaired by DYCEE(O&M) and following members attended the meeting.
 - a) Dy.CEE(O&M)
 - b) EE(West)
 - c) Asst. Manager Finance
4. During the meeting the technical proposal reviewed by above technical committee and discusses the technical proposal.
5. The second meeting of the committee was held on 10:00hrs dated 26-02-2025 and all the committee members attended the meeting. During the meeting the technical proposal was reviewed by above technical committee and after detailed deliberations some discrepancies were observed regarding mandatory requirement of evaluation criteria and other terms & conditions and the same were forwarded to Dy.CEE(S&C) vide Dy.CEE(O&M) letter No. (M)/Elect/DCEE(O&M)/2025/47 dated: 26-02-2025 for following shortcoming clarification was asked from bidders to furnish.

CLARIFICATIONS:

The committee again discuss the response received from bidders and reviewed the mandatory conditions of evaluation criteria. The committee after detail deliberations and discussions produces following observations:

OBSERVATIONS:

- **M/s. SSR Enterprises**

Above mentioned bidder does not have PEC registration certificate with technical code of EE-04 & EE-05 which is mandatory requirement of TEC for said tender (letter attached at S.No. 9). Hence does not evaluate further.

- **M/s. Al Meena Marine Engineers**

Above mentioned bidder does not have PEC registration certificate with technical code of EE-05 which is mandatory requirement of TEC for said tender (letter attached at S.No. 8). Hence does not evaluate further.
