The minimum technical (Legal Services Proposal) score required to pass is 70 Marks out of 100.

The evaluation of technical (Legal Services Proposal) and financial proposals shall be held under the QCBS method. The total score of technical (Legal Services Proposal) and financial evaluation shall be 100, out of which 70% weightage shall be for technical (Legal Services Proposal) and the remaining 30% weightage shall be for financial.



The technical proposals (Legal Services Proposal) will be evaluated on the basis of a legal firm's relevant experience, understanding of assignment, and the experience of professional staff. Only those legal firms whose technical proposals (Legal AServices Proposal) score 70 marks or more shall qualify for further consideration and shall be ranked from highest to lowest on basis of their technical (Legal Services Proposal) score. Financial proposals of those legal firms who secure less than 70 marks shall be returned un-opened to the legal firm, at the time as may be specified by SIDCL.

The technical proposals (Legal Services Proposal) shall be assigned marks/ score without weightage on the basis of the criteria.

70% = Technical (Legal Services Proposal)

30% = Financial

Law firm offering the lowest price would be awarded a score of 100. Rest of the legal firms would be awarded a lower score proportionately in accordance with their quoted price.

The fee for providing advisory services shall be quoted inclusive of all applicable taxes in Pakistan in the financial proposal.

The formula for determining the financial score is the following:

 $[SF=100 \times Fm / F]$

Where, Sf is the financial score; Fm is the lowest price and F the price of the bid under consideration.

Combined Score

The law firm getting maximum marks on 70-30 weightage (70% for technical and 30% for financial) shall be selected as the successful legal firm. The weights given to the technical (T) and financial proposals (F) are: T = 0.70 and F = 0.30 respectively. The formula for calculating the combined score is the following:

Combined Score = $TS*S_t + FS*S_f$



BASIC ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method in accordance with Procurement Rules read with Consultancy Regulations has been adopted for evaluating the bids. A bid received from a law firm, shall only be considered if all the following components (and the relevant requirements of the Bidding Documents) are in order /satisfactory manner:

> CONSTITUTIVE DOCUMENT

A detailed description of the legal firm including:

- · Legal name;
- Complete office contact information, including mailing address, telephone number and email address;
- Certificate of Incorporation or Registration.

Law firms participating in the bidding process should submit certified true copies of their constitutive documents.

> REGISTRATION WITH TAX AUTHORITIES

The law firm must possess a valid registration certificate from the income tax authority (i.e. the NTN certificate) and relevant sales tax authority, if applicable. Valid certificate(s) (in the name of the Law Firm) and tax returns filed for the last (03) three years are to be attached as are relevant sales certificate, if applicable.

➤ NO CONFLICT OF INTEREST

The law firm shall not have a conflict of interest. A law firm found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. SIDCL considers a conflict of interest to be a situation in which a party has interests that could improperly influence that party's performance of official duties or responsibilities, contractual obligations, or compliance with applicable laws and regulations. At the time of the selection process, a law firm may be considered to be in a conflict of interest with one or more parties if it, *inter alia*; participated as an adviser in the preparation on the specifications of this RFP.

➤ NON-BLACKLISTING

The law firm shall provide evidence in the form of an affidavit setting out as **Form A** and a declaration of eligibility / non-blacklisting by the Federal or Provincial Government as of the date of submission of the bid.

A law firm that has been blacklisted by any of its employers/clients while providing services in Pakistan, at the date of submission of the bid under the RFP or thereafter, shall not be considered.
